Name

• The name of this society is "The Benthological Society of Asia (BSA)".

Purposes

- To lead development of benthological sciences academically and to contribute to conservation and sustainable management of aquatic ecosystems in Asian countries
- To promote information exchange among members through regular and irregular meetings and communications

History

- Aquatic entomologists of Japan and Korea agreed to organize the Aquatic Entomological Societies in East Asia (AESEA) at the Japanese Society of Aquatic Entomology in Matsumoto, Japan.
- 1999. 7 Members of the Chinese Society of Aquatic Entomology joined AESEA.
- The 1st AESEA Symposium in Chiaksan, Korea.

Scope

The society includes the following technical fields of studies on benthos that inhabit rivers, streams, lakes, estuaries, coastal areas, and other water bodies.

- Systematics, phylogeny, and evolution
- Structure, function, and stability of populations, communities, and ecosystems
- Physiology and behavior
- Genetics and molecular biology
- Modeling, forecasting, and management
- Conservation of biodiversity
- Biological monitoring and assessment
- Development of methods
- Other research fields related to benthos and aquatic ecosystems

Membership and Organization

- Membership shall be open to experts or students in the fields of aquatic ecosystems and benthic communities.
- Membership shall be retained by the participation in the symposium to be held every two years along with payment of dues.
- The society shall be comprised of president, executive board members, advisory

members, and technical committees.

- The president (term: 2 years) shall represent the society, and call symposium and board/committee meetings.
- The executive board shall decide the important matters of the society including election of president and secretary general, nomination of executive board members and advisory members, decision of symposium venue, journal publication, and establishment of technical committees.
- Technical committees shall be organized for special purposes for fulfilling various society objectives for a long term basis.
- Geographical branches (national correspondents) shall be additionally formulated to promote society activities and communication.
- The organizers and steering committee, temporarily constituted by the organizers of the previous symposia (including AESEA) and past presidents, are active until the June 6, 2014 and shall appoint the 3rd president, symposium venue in 2016, advisory members (Attachment 1), executive board members (Attachment 2), and national correspondents (Attachment 3).

Society Activities

- A symposium shall open regularly every two years.
 (The third BSA symposium will be held in Vladivostok, Russia, in 2016; Dr. Victor BOGATOV of Russian Academy of Science, Vladivostok, Russia, was elected as the 3rd president of BSA: January 1, 2015 December 31, 2016)
- The society shall contribute to exchanging knowledge and information among members by publishing journals and newsletters.
- The society shall open the official website, "The Benthological Society of Asia (www.waterinsect.org)" for communication among members.
- The society shall exchange research and activities with other international societies on benthology and aquatic sciences.
- The following technical committees shall be launched.
- A committee for "Biomonitoring program" (Chaired by Kazumi TANIDA).
- A committee for "Taxonomic keys on Asian benthic macroinvertebrates" (Chaired by Yeon Jae BAE).

Publications

- Selected research papers presented in the first to fourth AESEA symposia were respectively published in the Proceedings of the International Symposium on Aquatic Entomology in East Asia (AESEA).
- Selected research papers were published in the proceedings of the first BSA symposium associated with the journal "Biology of Inland Waters" (ISSN 0286-8172).
- The selected papers presented in the second BSA symposium will be published in the "International Journal of Limnology (Edited by Young-Seuk PARK)" and "Entomological Research Bulletin (Edited by Young-Seuk PARK)."
- The society aims to publish an international journal which accommodates the research papers by the society members. A technical committee shall be formulated to steer publication of an official journal of the society.
