First Circular

On October 8-9, 2012, A.V. Zhirmunsky Institute of Marine Biology FEB RAS and Institute of Oceanology, Chinese Academy of Sciences will hold a bilateral symposium with main topic: Marine Ecosystems under the Global Change in the Northwestern Pacific. The symposium will combine oral presentations and discussions. Participants of the symposium are welcomed to submit extended abstracts or papers to be published as edited *Proceedings* of the symposium in advance; strict deadline is July 15, 2012. Only those papers will accepted whose authors will deliver ORAL presentations; no poster session is planned; merely publication of papers without oral presentation at the symposium is not possible.

Extended abstracts or papers (maximum 5 pages) should be prepared in Microsoft Word format, body text in Times New Roman font with 12pt size. References should be presented as follows, in alphabetical order (do not abbreviate journal names):
